School Vision and Mission



Teacher Professional Training and Development





English learning programmes and activities

To enhance students' English proficiency through increasing their exposure to authentic English outside the class, hence widening their horizons and strengthening their general knowledge, a number of English activities are regularly held, including English Debating Club, English Elite Debate Team, English Drama and so on. More able students are recruited as English Ambassadors who are trained to run regular English learning activities for fellow students such as crafts, English Cafe, English Day, song dedication, a peer reading support programme and English broadcasts about SAGC news. Form level outings to take part in English activities at places of interest are also offered, such as the Amazing Race at West Kowloon Cultural District, playing sports games at SuperPark and a visit to the historical site of Tai Kwun.

In order to strengthen students' English, after-school tutorials are held such as the Springboard Enrichment classes for gifted students and Remedial classes for less able yet hardworking ones. All these activities are to stimulate students' interest in learning English and enhance their confidence in using the language.

















Religious Education

Our school puts emphasis on religious education, which aims to let students understand Jesus is our role model in practising love and serving others. With the objective of nurturing students to have a positive attitude to cherishing life and admiring Jesus, all subjects have incorporated five core values of Catholic Education into the formal school curriculum. Besides, in order to promote positive Catholic values amongst students, students are encouraged to participate in different community services such as serving underprivileged families and joining the 'Charity Lunch' event. It is also hoped that students' spirituality will be fostered through various regular religious practices and activities, including morning prayers, prayer gatherings, Bible study competitions, religious assemblies and visits to the home for the elderly.

Through a wide range of activities, our school aims to guide students in their exploration of their strengths and to unleash their potential, as well as to cultivate students' gratitude and enhance their resilience, so that they can embrace challenges with grit and appreciate their own talents. Hence, they are able to develop positive attitudes and values to confront difficulties with hope.

Our students performed in an exemplary way and had consistent success in inter-school competitions. For an impressive fifth consecutive year, we proudly secured the championship in the Senior Division (Multimedia Production) at the 13th Inter-school Competition of Project Learning on Hong Kong's History and Culture, jointly organized by the Hong Kong Museum of History and The Hong Kong Institute for the Promotion of Chinese Culture.

Our dedication to historical literacy is further evident in the "Engage in reading to ring in National Day" Junior Secondary History e-Reading Award Scheme 2024. Our school has earned recognition for four consecutive years, claiming the "Creativity Award" for three years

Additionally, students earned a Merit Award from the Hong Kong Museum of the War of Resistance and Coastal Defence, participating in the "Learn from Museums--Novice Curator Training Programme."

Beyond history, our Geography curriculum emphasizes experiential learning. Recent excursions, including the "Ma Shi Chau Geo-Park Excursion" and the "Guangxi Guilin and Yangshuo Landform Exploration Trip," enhanced students' understanding of human-nature interactions, ecological balance, and national ecological sustainability.

At the same time, various subject teachers cooperate to promote subject-based electronic reading and create cross-subject reading exercises to strengthen students' reading abilities and broaden their reading horizons. Coupled with other reading activities and competitions, the campus has a strong reading atmosphere.
