# Teacher Professional Training and Development

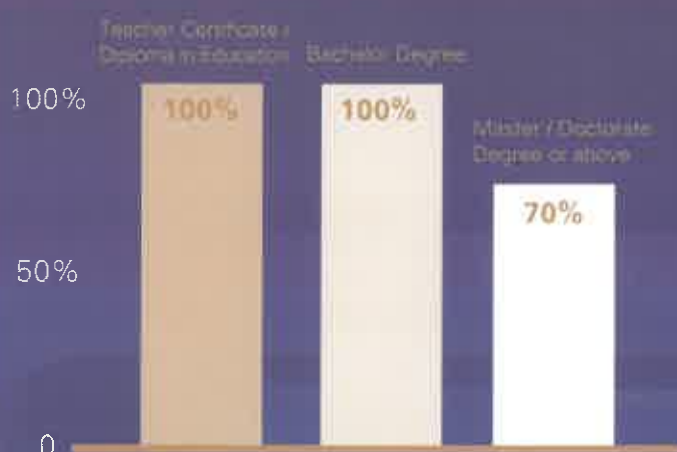

## Total number of teachers in the school

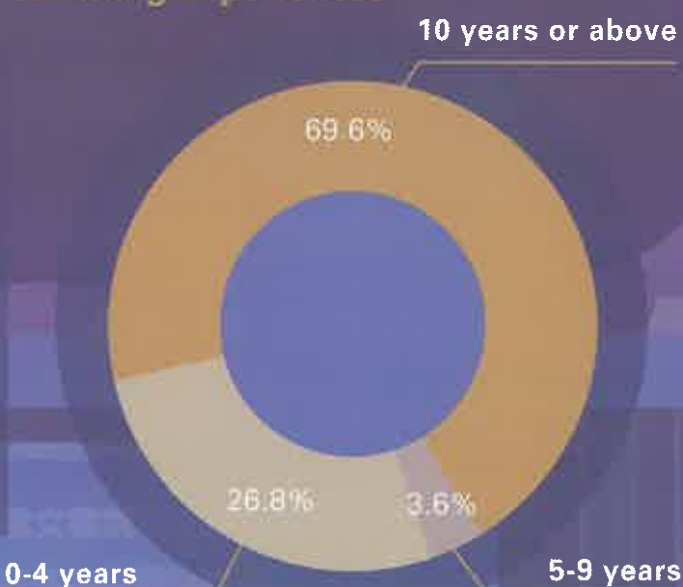

## English learning programmes and activities

To enhance students' English proficiency through increasing their exposure to authentic English outside the class, hence widening their horizons and strengthening their general knowledge, a number of English activities are regularly held, including English Debating Club, English Elite Debate Team, English Musical for Actors and Stage Crew and so on. Cross-curricular learning activities were also organized with other departments such as amazing race, making scones and sweet rice balls, playing bubble football and archery range. In order to strengthen students' English, after-school tutorials are held such as, Springboard Enrichment classes for gifted students and Remedial class for less able and hardworking ones. All these activities are to stimulate students' interest in learning English and enhance their confidence in using the language.

With the QEF grant, the school implemented a two-year English Drama Programme. This year, students showed their amazing talents by taking the stage and bringing to life the magic of the musical through dance, acting and song for the 50th Anniversary of our school and on Aesthetic Night – The Most Epic Birthday Party Ever. It was the first SAGC live musical performance after the pandemic. Besides staging a musical and running different kinds of drama activities during the whole year, drama lessons are also provided in junior forms to explore students' potential in different areas and maximise their opportunities to use English in a more creative way.

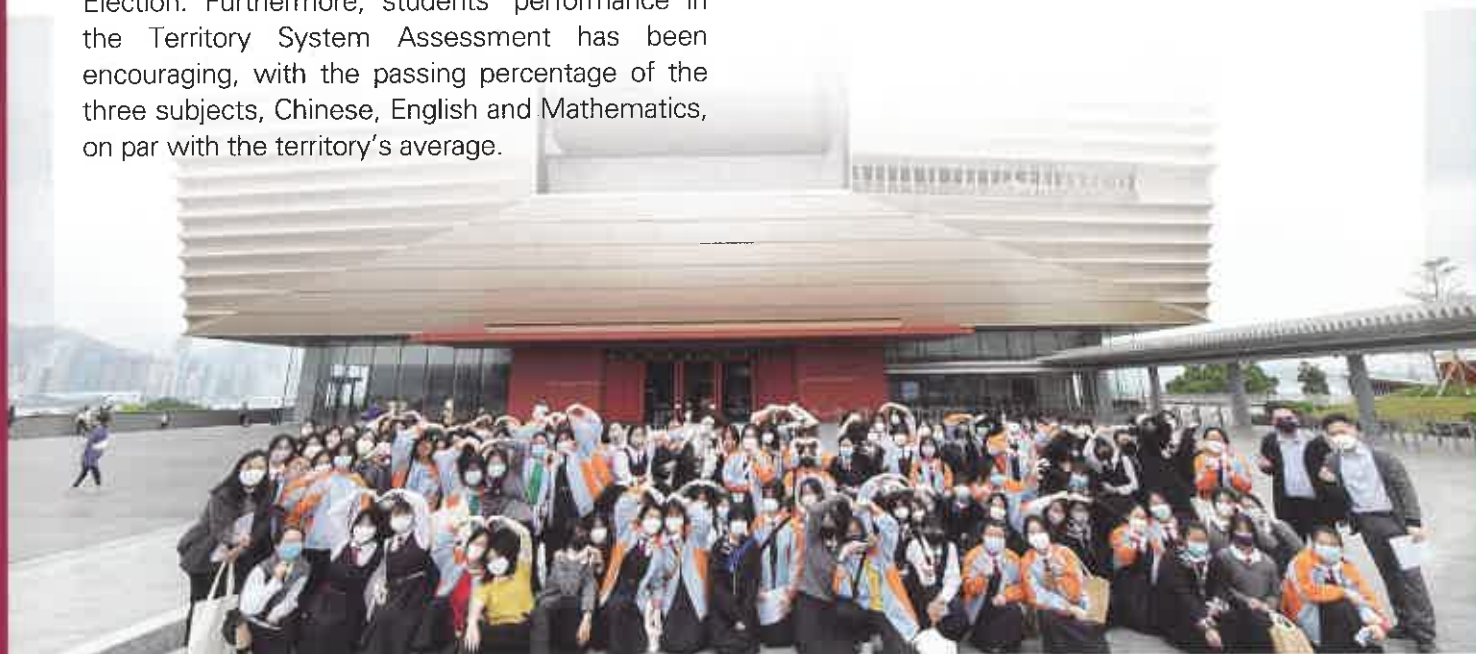

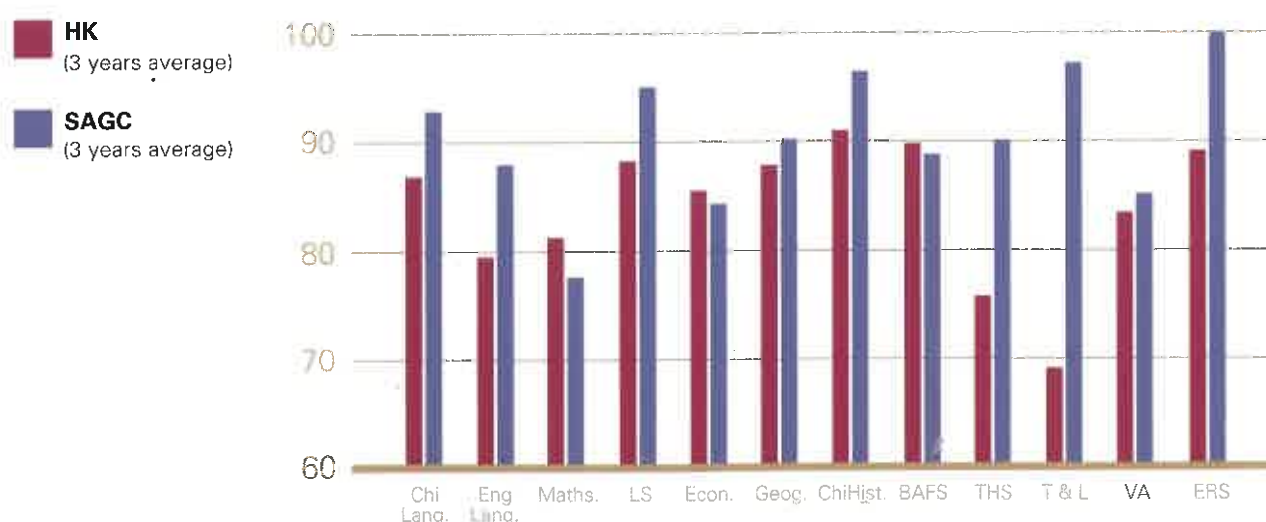
# Academic Achievement

As a result of our teachers' and students' hard work, students have performed satisfactorily in public examinations in recent years. In the Diploma of Secondary Education Examination, 12 subjects' pass percentage was on par with the territory's average. With their outstanding academic achievement, our school graduates were presented with a number of prominent prizes, including Harvard Book Prize Scholarship, Link University Scholarship and Kwun Tong Outstanding Student Award in the Kwun Tong Outstanding Students Election. Furthermore, students' performance in the Territory System Assessment has been encouraging, with the passing percentage of the three subjects, Chinese, English and Mathematics, on par with the territory's average.

Since 2013, more than 220 graduates of our school have studied for bachelor's degrees in local universities such as The University of Hong Kong, The Chinese University of Hong Kong, The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, The Hong Kong Polytechnic University and Hong Kong Baptist University. In the academic year of 2019-2022, over 90% of S6 graduates (three-year average) were successfully enrolled in a Bachelor's degree programme or an associate's degree / a Higher Diploma programme.

# Self-directed Learning

## Taking Initiative for all Stages of the Learning Process

Our school puts emphasis on cultivating students' self-learning habits. It is believed that through teaching students note-taking skills, helping them set learning goals and asking them to keep reflective learning journals, students can be more organized, self-disciplined and responsible for their learning. They are required to reflect on and evaluate their learning experience so as to gain a clearer view of their learning progress. Hence, their learning effectiveness will be enhanced.

## Remedial and Enhancement Classes for Junior Secondary Students

To cater for learner diversity, after-school remedial and enhancement classes in Chinese, English and Mathematics are run for junior secondary students with different learning abilities. It is believed that students' confidence and learning motivation can be boosted.

## Supplementary Classes for Senior Secondary Students

Our teachers have conducted supplementary classes for senior secondary students. S4 and S5 students are divided into groups according to their learning abilities and attend different supplementary classes after school from Tuesday to Thursday. To prepare S5 students for the upcoming public examinations, our teachers will conduct supplementary classes for S5 students during the summer holiday. Afterwards, students will sit for the school pre-mock examinations at the end of the holiday.

## Strengthening Summative Assessments

Aiming to cultivate students' regular study habits, our school conducts summative assessments on Monday mornings. It is hoped that this measure can provide our students with a rigorous learning atmosphere and improve their academic performance.

## Implementing E-learning at School

Our school has implemented the "Bring Your Own Device Programme (BYOD)" to stimulate students' learning interest and increase learning effectiveness.

## Reading for Unlimited FUN

The Reading Committee holds an activity named "Reading for Unlimited FUN". The aims of this reading programme are to cultivate reading culture in the school and promote extensive reading. Students are encouraged to read in groups and share their reading experiences and feelings by shooting short videos. They can come up with creative ideas and report their reflections on books in various ways, including storytelling, drama performances, experimental demonstrations and drawing comic strips. It is in the hope that students can find reading more interesting and enjoyable after taking part in this programme.

## Religious Education
